"Why conserve nature? Intrinsic or utilitarian value?"



The global extinction crisis is threatening diversity of live on Earth. The 20% most range-restricted and locally rare species are in highest peril. In contrast, ecosystem function and - in particular - provisioning ecosystem services - are predominantly determined by the most wide-spread and locally dominant species, which - with few exceptions - are not endangered. In the talk, I present and discuss evidence that suggests the biodiversity crisis is only weakly associated with threatening ecosystem collapse. Few disagree that humandriven extinction is an ethical wrong. Thus, nature conservation must be motivated with the intrinsic value of biodiversity and wild nature. I also discuss

the role scientists - in my opinion - should play in societies, communicating the truth, even when they fear it my harm political goals, with which they agree personally.
